The Bureau of Insurance (“Bureau”) notified 710 agencies on June 23, 2017 that the State Corporation Commission (“Commission”) had revoked their producer license to transact the business of insurance in Virginia effective June 21, 2017 because the agencies did not identify a “designated licensed producer” responsible for the agency’s compliance with Virginia’s insurance laws. The Commission’s Order (“Order”) required the agencies to wait thirty (30) days from the date of the Order before submitting an application to be licensed as an insurance agency.

The Commission has since modified its Order to allow affected agencies the opportunity to reapply and obtain their licenses immediately provided the agency includes the name of their “designated license producer” on the application. Furthermore, the Commission shall vacate the Order Revoking License for such agencies that reapply and provide the required information, which means there will be no gap in licensure or appointments.
