Another annual event is a social to benefit the Huntington Disease Society of America called Cocktails for a Cause in honor of IIAV member, Eddie Benson. In September, they not only received strong support in terms of attendance, but they exceeded the previous year's total donation. They were also able to bring the Benson family a great deal of love and support from the attendees.

In November, the young agents hosted a food drive for the Virginia Supportive Housing Group. Every year this organization prepares a dinner for the individuals they serve, IIAV was able to donate all the items needed and more, allowing VSH to utilize funds for their residents in other ways.

Just last week was the Young Agents' Annual Holiday Party, an event to thank all the company partners and the IIAV membership for their support throughout the year. This event encompasses a toy drive, from which collected 3 boxes of toys were donated to Toys for Tots.

"2017 was a big year for the IIAV young agents and we are excited to take this momentum into 2018 with many more remarkable things to come from this group," said Bob Bradshaw, CEO and President of IIAV.
